Since 2018 the Fund has been working to help halve road deaths and injuries in low- and middle-income countries, where over 90% of the 1.3 million fatal crashes occur each year.

Operating in 30 countries across 5 regions, at the end of 2021, the Fund actively supports better urban planning for school zones, low emission non-motorized transport, speed management and cleaner safer used vehicle standards.

The Fund's first pledging event on 30 June 2022 at the UN Headquarters in New York seeks to mobilize new partners and pledges of \$US 40 million for its projects in 2022-2025. Road safety is underfunded in most countries – pledges you make will be channeled to 60 additional countries in most need of support.

Fund Presentation (5 mins): Nneka Henry, Head of the UN Road Safety Fund Secretariat will highlight key results, challenges and opportunities of the Fund and highlight the critical role of the partners.

Private Sector Pledges (45 mins): Private sector and NGOs pledge announcements. **Joint Outcome Announcement (5 mins):** Olga Algayerova, Executive Secretary, UN Economic Commission for Europe will announce the total amounts pledged/contributed as announced by UN Member States in the HLM as by the private sector in the lunchtime event.
