The UN Road Safety Fund is pleased to announce that the UNRSF Call for Proposals 2022 is open $between 07 \ April 2022 \ and 30 \ June 2022 \ (23:59 \ CEST).$

Through this Call, the Fund will disburse **USD 4 million** to approved projects aimed at reducing road traffic fatalities and injuries that are implemented in low- and middle-income countries.

In accordance with the UNRSF Framework, all UNRSF projects must fall under one or more of the five "core" strategic priorities of the Fund: road safety management, safe roads, safe vehicle, safe user and/or post-crash response. Concept notes covering two or more core strategic priorities are encouraged and will be prioritized.

In accordance with the Global Plan for the Second Decade of Action 2021-2030, the following special strategic priorities are encouraged and will be prioritized:

- Projects addressing different development goals/policy agendas in addition to road safety
- Projects addressing multi-modal transport and land use planning
- Projects supporting regional (multi-country) collaboration to address common challenges

Only participating UN organisations (PUNOs) are eligible for direct access to funding under the UNRSF 2022 Call for Concept Notes. Projects submitted by two or more PUNOs will be prioritized.

Governments, international organizations, NGOs, research institutes and private sector entities that are interested in partnering with PUNOs to jointly prepare concept notes during the 2022 Call for Proposals are invited to consult the respective Stakeholder Engagement Strategies of the PUNOs here.
