

STRENGTHENING ROAD TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT IN BRAZIL

	2020 – 2021		US\$ 321,000 (UNRSF) + 387,000 (co-financing)

In Brazil 35,375 people died every year on the road. The fatality rate was almost twice more than in Europe.

The UNRSF project, coupled with government & civil society co-financing and equipment led to a decrease in the rate of traffic deaths.

GOALS:

- Train and qualify the traffic officers
- Raise awareness about road safety
- Promote investments in the road safety system in the Pará State



and more awareness of the global discussions on road safety.

FOCUS ON:

- Drinking and driving
- Distracted driving
- Non-use of mandatory equipment



RESULTS:

- Increasing number of coherence traffic enforcement checks per month:

from **360** to **837** in 2020

- Increasing use of the breathalyzer tests:

from **1,200** to **2,136** in 2020

IMPACT:

DECREASE IN THE RATE OF TRAFFIC DEATHS

from **17.03** to **15.64** per 100,000
