

## The UN Road Safety Fund Turns Four Today!

## 12 April 2022 - Geneva

The UN Road Safety Fund (UNRSF) celebrates its fourth anniversary today.

Since its inception in 2018, the Fund has been working to help halve road fatalities and injuries in low- and middle-income countries, where over 90% of the 1.3 million fatal crashes occur each year. At the same time, the Fund has been championing safe and green mobility that promotes healthy lives and lifestyles.

With 25 approved projects in five regions and 30 countries, and with US\$ 12.6 million disbursed to date, assistance is already going to support better urban planning for school zones, low emission non-motorized transport, speed management and cleaner, safer used vehicle standards.

The UNRSF's rapidly expanding public-private partnership currently includes 30 beneficiary partner countries; 20 private sector and government funders; 13 UN agencies and regional commissions; 5 celebrity champions; and the Global Alliance of NGOs for Road Safety. Through the dedicated support of this dynamic network, the UNRSF has been making an impact in cities and countries where it matters most by addressing critical gaps in national road safety systems.

With continued support from our partners, the UNRSF is investing in the Global Development Agenda to solve the road safety crisis. Together, we are building a world where roads are safe for every road user, everywhere.
